



NRHA Ancillary Show Guidelines

1. Entry deadlines, membership requirements and class fees will be published on the entry forms which can be found on nrhafuturity.com or nrhaderby.com.
2. Late entries made until two-days prior at noon will be included in the regular draw. Late entries made after this will be included as a negative entry. Late entries made after the draw is posted will run at the end of the class.
3. In the event of a 30-minute draw conflict (rider/horse or rider/trainer) between the Coliseum and the Adequan arena draw adjustments can be made with the draw position in the Coliseum receiving priority and remaining unchanged. The alternative draw position will be:
 - Moved to run as the last horse within a designated set selected by show management.Alternative draw positions will be decided at management's discretion.
4. Should a need arise to modify a class draw, modified draws may be placed as the first or last draw position in the class.
5. If an exhibitor will be schooling in an ancillary class the following guidelines will apply:
 - a. Exhibitors should present in proper show attire as outlined in the NRHA handbook.
 - b. Please indicate you will be schooling immediately after entering the arena.
 - c. Schooling exhibitors will be timed and excused from the arena after the same amount of time as it would take to complete the pattern listed in the class.
 - i. If excused from the pen please depart the arena in an expedited manner.
