The SHOW OFFICE WILL OPEN AT NOON – Tuesday, November 22. You'll need your numbers to ride in the arena beginning Tuesday evening, so be sure to come check in.


If you have Priority or VIP RV spots, please stop by the Horse Show office to **pick up the Parking Credentials to display in your RV/Bus/Trailer window. YOU MUST HAVE THESE DISPLAYED TO PARK IN PRIORITY OR VIP RV PARKING!**

Also remember, there is no move-in or setup until 12:01 am on Tuesday, November 22.

Currently, the NRHA Events team at the Byars, Oklahoma office is processing entries. At this point, the numbers look to be up from last year, with 406 in the Open Futurity and 205 in the Non Pro Futurity, along with still-escalating numbers in the ancillary and NAAC® classes.

NRHA Futurity tickets are available through the Oklahoma State Fair Box office and sales are brisk so order now!

Go to nrhafuturity.com and click on the TICKETS tab. You can select and order your tickets online or call the number listed if you need additional information or guidance.

To Order Additional Exhibitor Badges

Each horse entered in the show gets one NRHA Futurity Exhibitor badge. To order additional NRHA Futurity badges for general admission, go to <https://nrhafuturity.com/2022/badges.pdf>. The cost of an additional badge is \$60.

Pick up your Priority & VIP RV Materials Upon Arrival

If you have a space reserved in the VIP or Priority RV (west RV) lots, please pick up your window card at the show officeto display in a visible spot on your RV or trailer as soon as you arrive at the show. **YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO STAY IN THIS LOT WITHOUT permit displayed on your rig.**

Of course, there will be plenty of space available in the south RV areas. These do not require reservations.

CVI & Coggins Check-In Procedure Changes

The check-in procedure for the Futurity has changed this year. Instead of check-in at the front gate, your **30-day Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health certificate) and 1-year Coggins** must be presented in the horse show office to get your competition back numbers. Numbers will not be released without valid health papers and Coggins.

Here's the fine print for check-in requirements:

All horses and other equine must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI), formerly known as a health certificate or valid Equine Passport showing age, breed, sex and markings to positively identify the animals, including all vaccinations, date and result of required tests, and issued within 30 days of arrival and an official document verifying a negative test for Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) [Coggins test] showing a test date within 12 months prior to exhibition. Nursing foals less than 6 months of age, accompanied by their negative tested and documented dams, are exempt from test requirements. The laboratory conducting the test must be approved by APHIS, USDA.

You will still be checked in by OK State Fair Security at the front gate for information, but it will not be necessary to present health papers at that time.
